- §1. **Meeting starts**  
The chairman opened the meeting.
- §2. **Designation of minute reviewer (justeringsperson)**  
Hans Basun was assigned, together with the chairman, to approve the minutes.
- §3. **Approval of the agenda**  
The board *approved* the agenda.
- §4. **Declaration of conflict of interest**  
Part of the board members have a conflict of interest to §10 Budget. However, a block decision for the entire budget was made.
- §5. **Approval of minutes from the previous board meeting 8 October 2019**  
The board *approved* the minutes from the previous board meeting on 8 October 2019.
- §6. **Approval of delegated decisions**  
The board *approved* the delegated decisions that are summarized in appendix 2. The board mentioned that the text under "approved by" for the strategic grants should be changed from "steering group" to "Gunnar Gouras" and that it should be mentioned within parentheses when the

chairman has asked the steering committee for comments before making this type of decisions.

**§7. Update from management**

○ **Strategic document, and meeting with Deputy Vice-Chancellor's office**

MultiPark is working on both the 5-page strategic plan requested by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor's office (deadline for submission is January 10, 2020), and on the new MultiPark strategic plan.

○ **Educational follow-up about cancellation of Preparatory course, and plans for PI lectures**

The Preparatory course will be discontinued.

It is suggested that Senior researchers within MultiPark give short overview lectures on certain occasions to PhD students/postdocs to improve interaction.

○ **PhD student and postdoc initiative to interact with patient organizations**

Suggestion from PhD students and postdocs to organize student run seminars in collaboration with Parkinson's- and Alzheimer's disease patient organizations.

○ **New working group**

A working group, starting January 2020, has been created to support the management with the workload, and help prepare matters for the steering group meetings. The board stressed that the name should be changed from "Executive group" to "working group", and that the "working group" may not make any decisions.

**§8. Request to purchase new Cellomics imaging system**

The board *approved* the application with the maximum amount of 3 770 700 SEK, but stressed that the purchase must be procured via LU Purchasing and Procurement department.

**§9. Request to fund the service contract for the Light sheet microscope**

The board *approved* the application, with the amount of 265 760 SEK in direct costs but stressed that the purchase must in advance be confirmed via LU Purchasing and Procurement department.

**§10. Budget**

○ **Suggestion to increase travel grants to 800 000:-/year**

○ **Financing of MultiPark faculty positions**

○ **Two-photon microscopy platform reduced since the demand is less than expected**

The board *approved* the budget for 2020, a bloc decision for the whole budget was made. All costs include indirect costs estimated at 23,5%. The budget is provided as an appendix.

The budget is essentially the same as the previous year (2019) with some changes:



- The budget post Travel grants was increased to 800 000 SEK / year
- The budget posts for Two-photon Microscopy Platform was reduced to 600 775 in total (as proposed by the responsible PI)
- MultiPark funded salaries to professors, and senior lecturers was adjusted so that they follow the directive from the Medical faculty, according to "Resursfördelning 2014-2020". To ease the effects of withdrawn overhead coverage, and due to the short notice, the board decided that in addition to the salary (according to "Resursfördelning 2014-2020"), additional support should be paid as follows:  
75% of the overhead costs should be covered by MultiPark the first year (2020). 40% of the overhead costs should be covered by MultiPark the second year (2021), and thereafter no coverage of overhead costs.

Gunnar Gouras and Roger Olsson left the room during the discussion/ decision for this item due to conflict of interest. Oskar Hansson also left the room during the discussion/decision for this item.
